Interesting Facts

- ❖ Daniel, whose name means “God is my Judge,” wrote this book in Babylon, probably near the close of his life, 533 BC.
- ❖ Sir Isaac Newton said, “Christianity itself might be said to be founded on the prophecies of Daniel.”
- ❖ Like Ezekiel, the book of Daniel resembles Revelation in its symbolic language and its focus on “what shall come to pass” (2:28-29, 45) and “the time of the end” (8:17, 19, 23).
- ❖ Chapters 2:4-7:28 were written in Aramaic, or Chaldee, the rest in Hebrew.
- ❖ Daniel has 12 chapters, 357 verses, 11,602 words and can be read in about 1 hour and 15 minutes.

The Universal Dominion of the God of Redemption

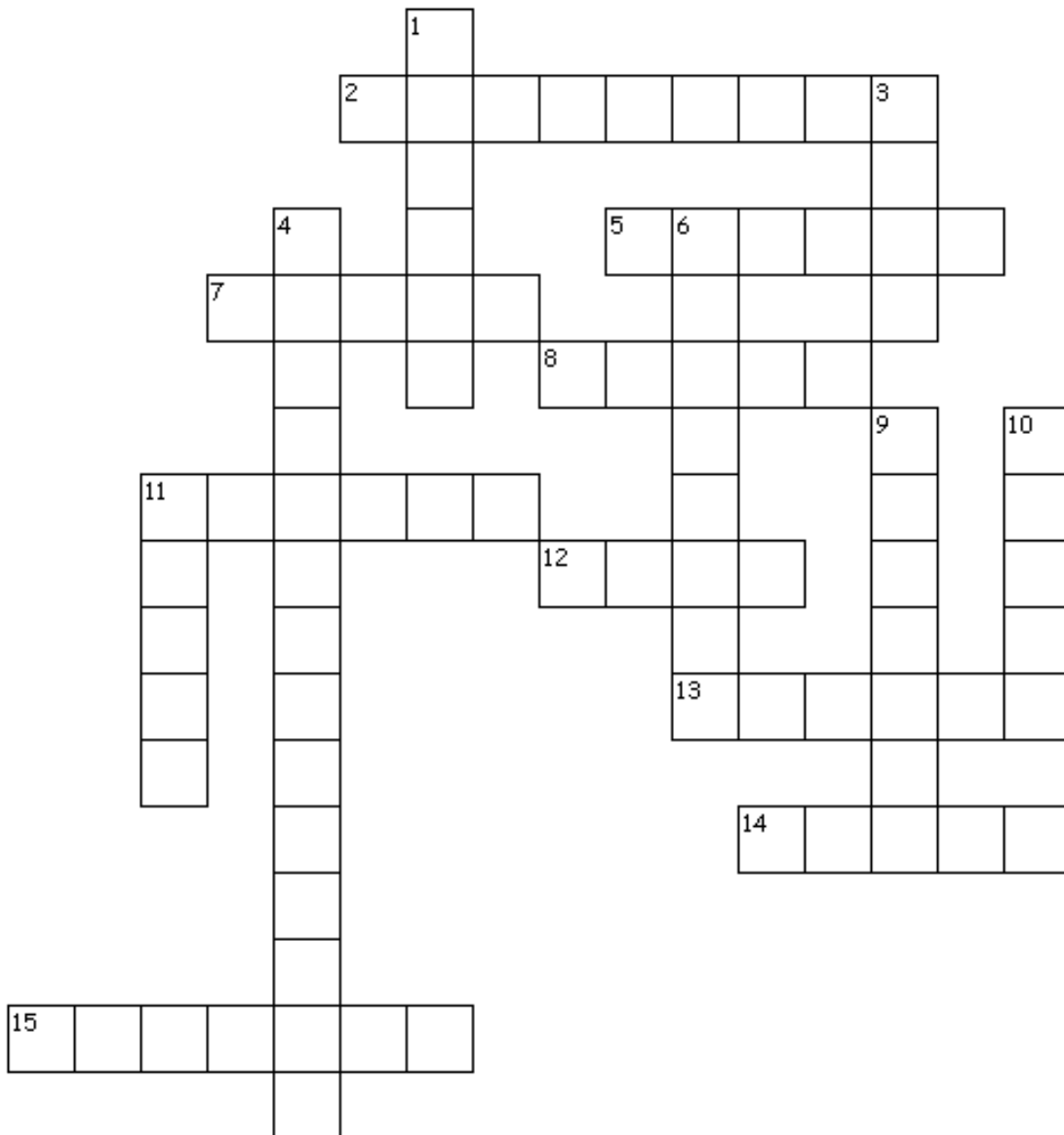
