- ❖ The name "Exodus" comes from the Greek meaning "going out."
- ❖ The book gives the redemption of Israel by God through the blood of the Passover.
- ❖ With Genesis, Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy-Exodus completes the five books known as the Pentateuch and Torah
- ❖ Exodus has 40 chapters, 1213 verses, 32685 words and can be read by the average reader in 3 hours.
